91-93 deposits have been received for Spring Trip so far. The deadline for the second payment of \$200.00 is due on Monday, January 11th.

There was fall transportation money left over due to the cancellation of one of the charter bus trips. The 89 students that paid that fee will receive a credit to their account in the amount of \$42.11.

Orchestra and Chorus have paid us for their portion of the fall fruit.

Upcoming expenses will include Indoor Instruction in the amount of \$8000.

Entry fees of \$800.00 for Indoor Competitions have been paid.

Hospitality is over budget by about \$100 so far. We will take a look at how to handle that line item in the budget.

Mr. Auman is looking into finding a truck to replace ours since it will not last another marching season.
