

Godwin Band Uniforms

Students will Change into Full Uniform @ Godwin!

~ All students will be dressing together in the hallways.

Marching Band T-Shirts & Shorts

should be worn under uniforms for all performances.

In colder weather, thermal or long-sleeve shirts can be layered under marching t-shirt.

Black tights, leggings or thermals can be layered under shorts.

Memorize your Uniform Jacket Number

You will need to be able to identify it if it is taken off to eat!

Please Bring to School on all Game and Competition Days:

- ~ **Marching Band T-Shirt**
- ~ **Marching Shoes (Dinkles)** - please mark your name **INSIDE** each shoe.
- ~ **Marching Gloves** (if applicable)
- ~ **Black Socks (mid-calf or higher)**
- ~ **Drum Majors ONLY: White Socks (mid calf or higher)**

Quick Tip:

Students can use a small drawstring bag for their band items for easy grab & go when changing! Please include deodorant for after rehearsal!

It is the student's responsibility to take good care of their uniform while it is in their possession.

Cleaning and/or replacement of negligent wear or damage to a uniform will be the financial responsibility of the student.

Part of the grading for events is based on students having ALL COMPONENTS of their performance attire for each event.

Section Leaders will inspect their Sections prior to each Event!

Long hair needs to be pulled up and under your hat for performances. Use bobby pins or a headband to hold loose hair back.

No Jewelry is visible (exception: medical alert bracelet).

No Sunglasses.

No Temporary Hair Color (spray on color, temporary dyes, etc.). Dyes can bleed onto the band of your hat or uniform & cause permanent damage.

No Spirit Makeup (Painted on Godwin symbols, decorations or eagles, football underliner, extra heavy makeup, etc.). Dyes can bleed onto uniform & cause permanent damage.

No gloves or jackets on when handling or eating food. Students will be instructed when they are allowed to eat at events.

Plumes are **ONLY** to be handled with gloves to avoid skin oils deteriorating the feathers. The Uniform Committee will add & remove plumes going on & off the field.
